### WorkSource Oregon Definitions Policy

#### Purpose

This policy defines “WorkSource Center” and “WorkSource Partner” for the purposes of branding the state and local workforce development system. The brand is WorkSource Oregon. WorkSource Centers and Workforce Partners as defined in this policy may be identified with the brand.

#### Definitions


WorkSource Center -- A One-Stop Career Center where job seekers and employers can receive a broad range of services and are chartered/certified by the local workforce investment board.

WorkSource Partner – Partners that are identified by the local workforce investment board.

#### Appeal

Local partners who disagree with local boards’ application of the above definitions may appeal the decision to the Local Workforce Investment Board (LWIB). If, after having exhausted all LWIB appeal or grievance procedures, and if the person or organization filing the appeal is not satisfied with the decision, the decision may be appealed to the Commissioner of the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development.

All such appeals shall be in writing and clearly state the nature of the complaint. The Commissioner shall have 90 days to act on the appeal. All decisions on such appeals by the Commissioner shall be final.
